Autonomous print & copy kiosk for self-service in any environment

Designed for public work spaces such as libraries, universities, and internet cafes, this kiosk allows users to print on a pay-per-use basis or add credit to an existing account. The kiosk can be configured to accept everything from cash payments to debit and credit cards, providing the necessary flexibility for users whilst still safeguarding security and business profitability.

- With a user account, users can print directly from their mobile, tablet or PC through an application or web interface.
- Provides change to users from a self-replenishing change module with overflow coins dropping into a secure lock box.
- Accepts credit & debit cards via the approved Nayax terminal.
- Add credit to existing account this kiosk allows users to add credit to their existing student or user account.
- Huge range of handy features including door alarm, print management for unlimited users, and more.
- cBot works with the easy to use and manager Nayax, bank card terminal.
- Built with security in mind, the cBot comes as standard with a warning message for door opening and reporting of cash collection.
- The device is locked at the rear of the machine and is supplied with 2 keys. An additional key can be stored at a separate location for peace of mind.
- cBot terminals can be wrapped in a custom vinyl to match the client's brand and corporate identity.
